Good Quality Brand: McSpadden

Quality Beginner Model: Back Yard Music

You will want geared tuners & a 6 1/2 fret added

Scrolls are hard to tune

Tear Drop shape hard to keep in lap (w/o strap)

Hour Glass Shape best for lap

Strum: In: good for strum & melody string

Out: more power, good for picking

Strings: Change every 3 - 6 months if played often

Stretch the string after you put it on to begin the stretching process.

Chair: "Quick-E-Seat" tripod chair found at Bass Pro Shop

Capo: Ron Ewing Capo recommended.
